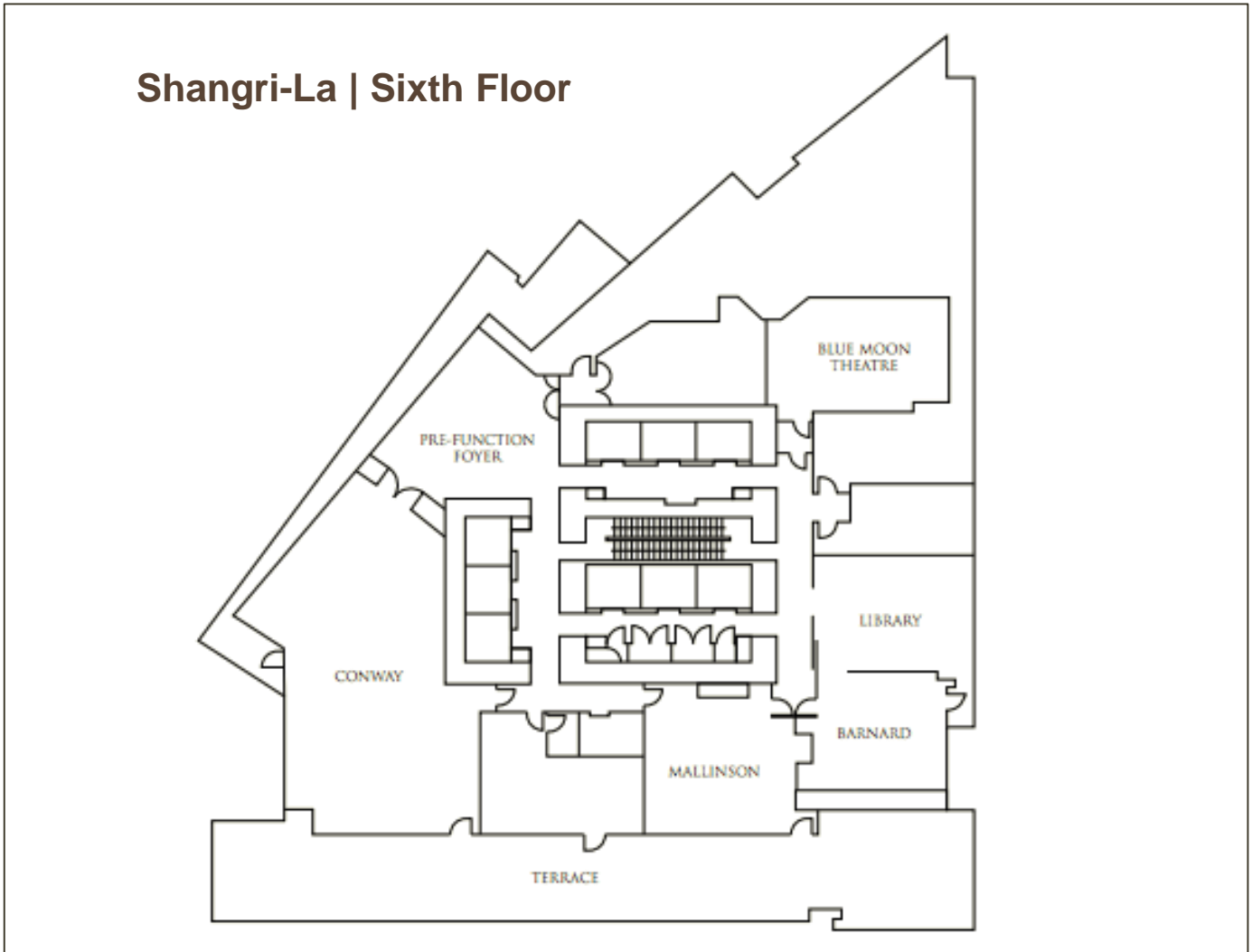

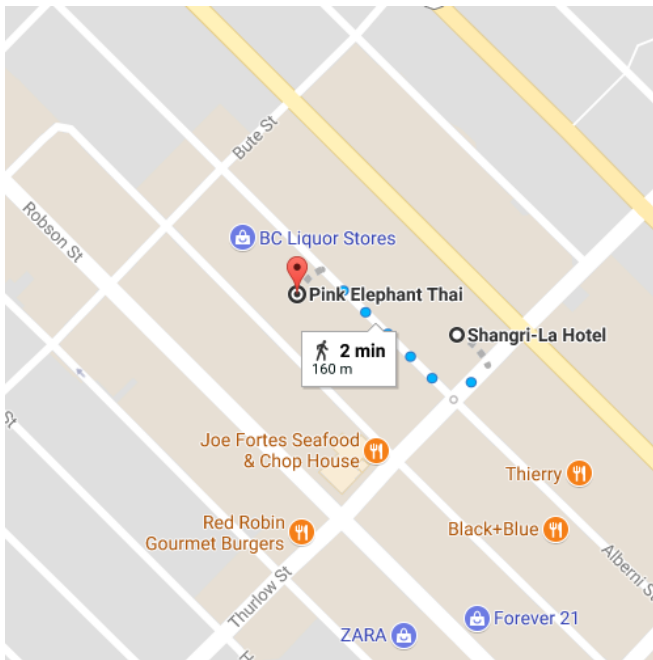

2. Turn right onto Alberni St

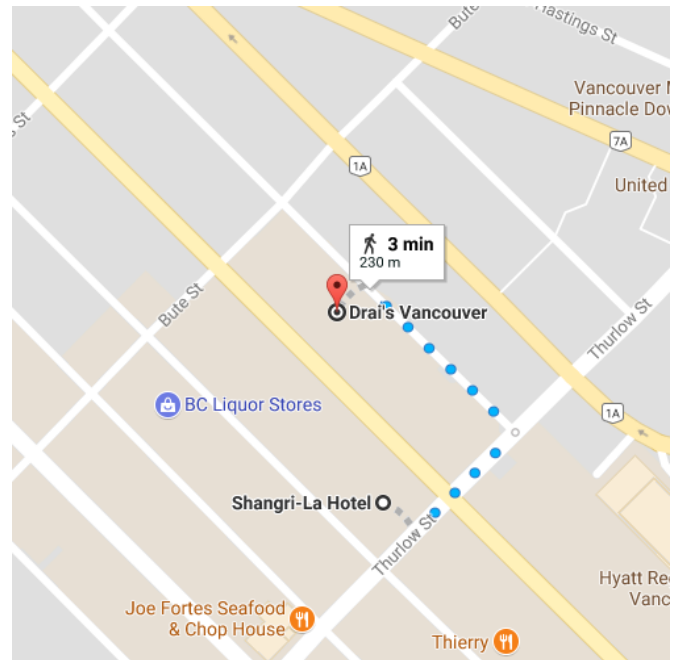

Tim is the Vice-President, Corporate Finance, for fast-growing Shoes.com, where he was recognized by Business in Vancouver as one of the city's Top 40 Under 40 in 2015 for his work, including the acquisition of Shoeme.ca and OnlineShoes.com. He also runs the Corporate Finance Institute, providing practical training on financial modelling and applications of finance for any professional.

Tim joined CIBC World Markets in Vancouver in 2005, and later joined Scotiabank Global Banking and Markets in 2007, where he managed portfolios of high-net-worth clients worth a combined \$120 million.

Outside of his current role at Shoes.com, Tim has worked on side projects such as Mathers Pacific Capital Inc., which he founded in 2013. He still runs the venture, which provides practical training for students and financial professionals.

Investment Banking Simulation

Delegates will be given the opportunity to experience, first-hand, a significant aspect of investment banking. Using a completed DCF valuation, a set of comparables and precedent transactions, and a template pitch book, delegates will be given 2 hours to value a business, a company, or structure an M&A transaction. They will then present to investment banking professionals who will act as clients in the presentation and Q&A. The simulation will conclude with a debrief and feedback.
